EPISODE #2: The Instigating Short Story:

'10 THINGS I HATE ABOUT YOU'

(Based on 'Taming of the Shrew' by William Shakespeare)

This is the Dialogue (or Story) the teen character, Kat Stratford, shares with the boy who has been pursuing her:

I hate the way you talk to me and the way you cut your hair.
I hate the way you drive my car.
I hate it when you stare.
I hate your big dumb combat boots and the way you read my mind.
I hate you so much it makes me sick; it even makes me rhyme.

I hate it that you're not around.
And the fact that you didn't call.
But mostly I hate the way I don't hate you, not even close, not even a little bit, not even at all.
