## BEGINNING SHORT SCRIPTWRITING CLASS w/ Trayce

You'll learn the fundamentals of scriptwriting, from mastering proper format to crafting multi-dimensional characters and compelling storylines that engage and surprise audiences.

ASSIGNMENT: Craft a compelling story set in a single location with just two to three characters, using strong visual imagery to bring it to life. You'll write two drafts of your script, receiving in-depth feedback and suggestions from the instructor and bouncing off fellow students in Writer's Room-style brainstorming sessions.

A Crash Course In The Creative, Technical, & Team Process Of Making A No-Budget Short Film !

Assuming the roles of Writer / Director, Trayce, draws on a student story idea to demonstrate how to craft a new story that has complex characters with layered relationships; a dynamic and believable storyline with clear themes; and vivid visuals. Actors are recruited and rehearse. Students become crew. A1 Day1 Productions teaches an introduction to camera, lighting, and sound, and then shoots the practice film. Students later can view raw footage and receive Editing Notes.
